Pennies for Pinellas

Brian Smith of Pinellas County reported on the Pennies for Pinellas County. He indicated that it has been extend for the years 2010 to 2020, however, conservative estimates were made for revenues. A workshop will be held in May to review the revenues and how the distribution will be affected. He will let President Lawrence know of the exact date of the meeting.

Beach Updates:

Treasure Island Long Key Project; will provide an update next meeting. It is a possibility that the Belleair Causeway will open in May. Estimated date for the Belleair City Hall completion is end of July to September. Fire works display in Redington Shores if enough donations are received. A Green Expo, will be held on Sunday, March 29 in St. Pete Beach. Also a European Market is now held on weekends. Madeira Beach will be having fire works this year.

Ray's Day will be held on June 14, 2009, (Flag Day). Tickets are available at the chambers of commerce in Clearwater and St. Pete Beach, as well as at Indian Shores Town Hall, Indian Shores Police Department, and Madeira Beach City Hall. Free parking is available for cars of 4 or more.

All guests were thanked for their presentations. The Mayor's Breakfast sponsored by the Tampa Bay Beaches Chamber will be held on April 20, 2009, at the Doubletree in North Redington Beach. Next meeting guest speak will be Brian McClure, meteorologist, he wiill provide a presentation on Hurricane Awareness.
