3. Approval of Agenda

4. Approval of Minutes

5. Approval of May 2017 Treasurer's Report

The \$35 million requested will be used to continue the Gulf Boulevard Beautification Project, improving and upgrading the corridor.

7. New Business

Tracy Fanara, E.I., Ph.D., Program Manager, Environmental Health from Mote Marine Laboratory showed a Power Point Presentation in regard to Red Tide and the beach condition reporting system. The website is <http://visitbeaches.org> and reports on beach conditions in the Southwest coast and the panhandle of Florida. The reports are provided through phone-based Global Positioning System (GPS).

8. Old Business

Mayor Soranno provided an update on Sand Key re-nourishment and the difficulty with obtaining easements in perpetuity from a few water-front residents.

John Bishop responded that the project is finalized and no additional changes are allowed. Mr. Bishop expects the contract will be awarded by the end of September. He noted that 6,300' of beach will not be re-nourished due to lack of easements obtained and suggested notification be sent to property owners.
