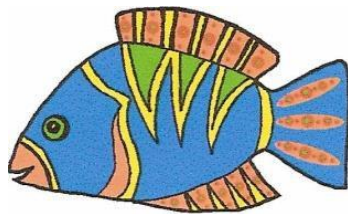

3. Changes to the Agenda and Approval

Mayor Queen moved to approve the agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Mayor Gattis and carried unanimously.

4. Approval of Minutes August 31, 2022

Mayor Kennedy moved to approve of the regular BIG-C (Barrier Islands Governmental Council) meeting of August 31, 2022 as presented. The motion was seconded by Mayor Hendricks and carried unanimously.

5. Approval of the August and September 2022 Treasurer’s Report

Mayor Queen moved to approve the August and September 2022 Treasurer’s Report as presented. The motion was seconded by Mayor Gattis and carried unanimously.

6. Correspondence

Digital Eel Invoice in the amount of \$266.57 was presented by Treasurer Mayor Kennedy. This invoice reflects updates to the BIG C website and 1 year of web hosting from November 1, 2022 – October 31, 2023.

7. New Business

Consideration of the Tentative 2023 Big C Meeting Schedule. Mayor Payne of Treasure Island noted that he had a conflict with his date of September 27, 2023 and it was agreed to re-address the schedule at the December 2022 meeting.

Cathie Perkins (Director of Pinellas County Emergency Management) presented detailed information as a follow-up on Hurricane Ian, lessons learned. Full report can be obtained through Pinellas County Emergency Management Office.

Mayor Johnson questioned if ‘wind field’ refers to both size and intensity of a storm and yes this is the case. It was also questioned by Mayor Johnson if possibly Pinellas County should include hotels in the mandatory evacuation plan, as is done with assisted living facilities and trailer homes, etc.? Also, Mayor Johnson wondered if possibly the County Building Codes should be changed to be stricter on the barrier islands to handle hurricane possibilities? County Administrator, Barry Burton questioned the BIG C members on whether that would be what the municipalities would want? Mayor Kennedy recommended the possibility of having a text chain from Emergency Management to the municipal leaders to keep them apprised of emergency situations. It was noted

that not only City Managers are welcome to participate in the EOC calls, all are welcome. Mayor Hendricks noted some key situations that happened in his municipality.

Adam Rudd and Brent Burish HCA Florida gave a brief presentation on Largo Medical Center that is now HCA Florida. He provided favorable statistics and information about HCA and the positive impact in Pinellas County that they are determined to have for our communities.
